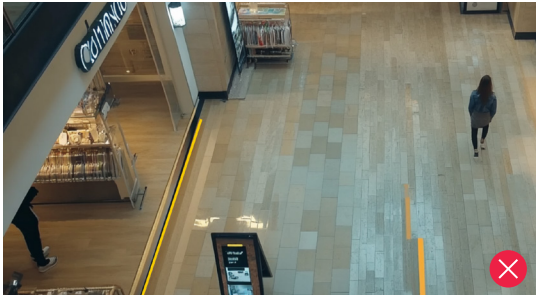


To achieve optimal performance for Videoloft's people counting, follow these guidelines when setting up your camera:



1. Full visibility

Position the camera so that the entire entrance or exit area is clearly visible within the camera's field of view.



It is also important to ensure the full height of a person can be seen.



2. Obstructions

Make sure there are no objects or barriers that might block the view of people crossing the line.



3. Camera distance

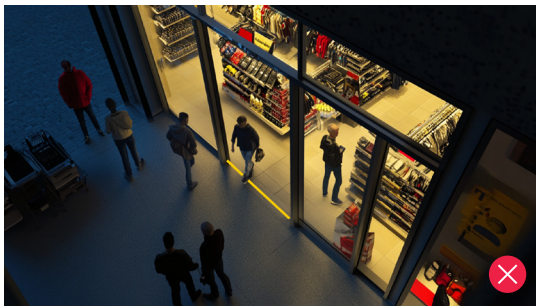
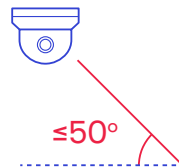
Ensure the camera is less than 12 feet (3.5m) away from the count line.





4. Camera height

Ensure the camera is positioned at a height where the angle from the count line to the camera is no more than 50 degrees.



5. Illumination

Ensure there is adequate lighting on both sides of the line to enhance visibility and detection accuracy.



6. Avoid waiting areas

Avoid using an area where people will be waiting or standing stationary, as this can lead to inaccurate counts.
